It's better to practice a little bit every day so your muscles have time to rest.

Humpback Letters all start at the middle line, go down to the bottom (or below) and back up to the middle to make a hump or circle.




To make these letters, start at the middle and go all the way down to the stop sign, then lift your pencil to make the second stroke.




