

CRAFT TO GO






MATERIALS

- 10 -15 Strips of magazines 1 Clasp and 1 jump ring
- White alue
- 6 feet of string
- Toothpick or pencil

FOLDING MAGAZINE STRIPS



STEP ONE

Fold a magazine strip in half lengthwise. Make sure the colors you want to show are on the outside of the fold. Add a little glue along the inside to help hold it closed.



STEP TWO

Fold the strip in half lengthwise again. Add a little glue.




STEP THREE

Fold the strip lengthwise one more time. Add a little glue.



COILING MAGAZINE STRIPS



STEP FOUR

Fold a small part of the end of the magazine strip in on itself leaving a small hole for the center of the bead. You can use a toothpick or tip of a pencil to help you make the hole.

Then begin rolling the rest of the magazine strip around this. Add a little glue occasionally to help hold it.

ASSEMBLING NECKLACE

















STEP FIVE

Fold the string in half. Put the jump ring in the middle of the string. Loop the string around the jump ring another time.

STEP SIX

Lay your beads out in the order you'd like them on the necklace. You may have extra beads.

STEP SEVEN

Tie an overhand knot about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches from the jump ring.

Pass one of the strings through one side of your first bead. Then pass the other string through the opposite side of the bead.

STEP EIGHT

Pull the bead toward the knot, leaving a little gap between the knot and the bead. Tie another overhand knot near the bead. Center the bead between the knots.

STEP NINE

Tie a knot about 1 inch from the previous knot. Then add another bead. Repeat the pattern until you have about 3 inches of string left.

STEP TEN

Add the clasp to one string. Use both strings together and knot the clasp in place about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches from the last knot.

Add a tiny bit of glue to the knot to hold it. Wait until the glue has dried before cutting off the excess string.
