## Pom-Pom Penquins!



#### What's Included:

- Black and white chunky yarn
- 2 small pieces of felt
- 2 googly eyes

### Instructions:

To create the body pom-pom:

- 1. Cut a piece of white yarn about 8 inches long. Then slide it between your fingers.
- 2. Wrap the yarn around 4 fingers wrap the white yarn first about 30 times. Then wrap the black yarn right next to it about 40 times.
- 3. Take the yarn you slid between your fingers initially & wrap it around the middle of the yarn as shown- tie it as best as you can.

  \*\*Don't knot it yet, just tie it tight enough to keep the wrapped yarn together when you slide it off your fingers.\*\*
- 4. Slowly slide the wrapped yarn off your fingers and then tie the knot as tightly as you can.
- 5. Use very sharp scissors, and carefully slide them into the outside loops of the yarn ball as shown, cutting your way around the circle.

#### What You'll Need:

- Hot glue gun
- Scissors

## Pom-Pom Penguins!



### Instructions:

- 7. To make the head pom-pom, repeat the steps above with the following 2 changes:
  - a. Only wrap the yarn around 2 fingers.
  - b. Wrap the white yarn 25 times, and wrap the black yarn 40 times.
- 8. The pom-poms will look very messy. In order to shape them, trim your way around each of the pom-poms with scissors until you've made even, round balls as shown.
- 9. Attach the smaller pom-pom to the larger pom-pom using a generous amount of hot glue from a glue gun as shown.
- 10. Cut out the shape for a beak and feet with the yellow felt and cut a piece long enough to wrap around the penguin for a scarf with the second piece of felt.
- 11. Using a hot glue gun, attach the beak & feet to the pom-poms
- 12. Attach the googly eyes to the smaller pom-pom with the glue gun.
- 13. Wrap the scarf around the penguin's neck, and add a small dab of glue where the scarf crosses itself to hold it in place.
