Material Request

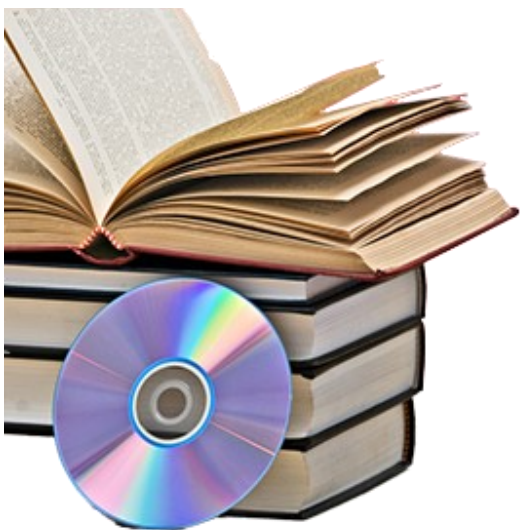
If you wish to request something that is not in our catalog, you can fill out the materials request form on our website or ask staff at the Information Desk.

Loan Periods

Blockbuster	3 days
New fiction, nonfiction, & DVDs.....	14 days
Other fiction & nonfiction.....	28 days
Books on CD	28 days
CDs, games, & juvenile holiday books	7 days
Hotspots	14 days

Item requests—holds — are held for 7 days.

Borrowing limits vary by card type. Check with staff for information.

Digital Media

E-materials can be accessed using a card with borrowing privileges. Specific providers, item limitations, and loan periods vary depending on current subscriptions.

Alerts & Renewals

An email or text alert will include:

- Courtesy notices of upcoming due dates
- Overdue notices
- Notices that requested items are ready for pick up or cancelled

Need More Time With Your Items?

Renew! No more than four renewals per item are allowed.

The system will renew items automatically except for:

- Blockbuster DVDs
- Items with holds
- ILL items

Access your account online, in-person, or over the phone to check the status of renewed items.

Online Account Access

1. Visit www.munciepubliclibrary.org and click on **[My Account]**.
2. Enter in your library card number and PIN (Personal Identification Number). If you forget your PIN, ask staff at the Circulation Desk for assistance.
3. You will now be able to:
 - View list of items currently checked out
 - Request items
 - Place, freeze, or cancel holds
 - Pay fines and fees

Fines & Fees

There is a fine for items returned late or damaged. *See the complete list of Fines & Fees in the Operations Policies online.*

Internal checkout of laptops	\$1/hour
Hotspots	\$3/day
Games	\$1/day
Activity Kits	\$1/day
DVDs	10¢/day
Books & all other items	10¢/day
Indiana State Museum Pass	\$1/day
Eiteljorg Museum Pass	\$1/day
Interlibrary Loan	25¢/day
Interlibrary Loan not picked up	\$2/item

Replacement Library Card

First replacement card is *free*. Every card after that is \$1.

Damaged Items

Charged at cost to repair or replace material as listed in the MPL system.

Overdue Fees

If your fines are less than \$10 you can still check out items.

Collection Agency

We use a collection agency to retrieve overdue items and fees once your fines reach \$25 and higher.
